MUMMS is a rural ministry in southern Iowa that exists to spread the Gospel and to facilitate the growth of United Methodist churches. Inspired by the Church's response to flooding in 1993, MUMMS was launched in 1996, offering a variety of opportunities for ministry from work team projects to after-school programs.

Peg writes, "God has shown me over

the years that there are children everywhere *but* in our churches." She recalls one community where she organized a weekly after-school program.

"The United Methodist Church averages seven in worship on Sunday, but *every* Tuesday we have 18 to 22 children come to learn about Jesus!
